## **INVESTOR PROTECTION INFORMATION FORM**

Pursuant to N.J.A.C. 13:47A-2.14

The New Jersey Bureau of Securities ("Bureau"), an arm of the Office of the New Jersey Attorney General, is charged with protecting investors from investment fraud, and regulating the securities industry in New Jersey. In addition to bringing investigative and enforcement actions against firms or individuals who violate the <a href="New Jersey Uniform Securities Law">New Jersey</a> and <a href="regulations">regulations</a> thereunder, the Bureau registers securities offered or sold in New Jersey and oversees the firms and individuals selling securities or providing investment advice to or from New Jersey.

Investors can contact the Bureau to research the professional background of current and former registered broker-dealers, investment advisers, agents, and investment adviser representatives.
